In order to be recognised by GFSI, CPOs must verify that they meet the Benchmarking Requirements, one of the world's most widely-accepted benchmark documents for food safety programmes.

These Certification Programme Owners currently have standards benchmarked and recognised against Version 2020 of the GFSI Benchmarking Requirements.
